Food Distribution

- Coordinate and maintain a local community network for food, seed and plant distribution
- Weekly preparation, driving, and delivery of food, seeds, plants, and medicine to community partner organizations and families; including pickups from farm partners
- Maintain food distribution log and documentation of all Foodways related activities

Foodways Education

- Support Native Foodways educational events and workshops, including Spring Planting and Fall Harvesting gatherings, community workdays and events, student visits, youth workshops, cooking classes, and other relevant and requested educational program

Land Tending

- Support farming/growing/land tending activities on the ground across all sites as directed
- Participate in TCC farm operations and partner meetings

Farm Field Work

Seeding & propagation, transplanting, raised bed creation and preparation, composting, weeding, harvesting, washing & packing produce, irrigation installation and repair, tool maintenance, and other farm-related tasks.



Land Tending

Brush clearing, native plant pruning, swale digging, tree felling and wood chipping, small equipment operation, infrastructure installation, and other land-based tasks.



Supporting Farm Systems & Activities

Supporting general farm organization, field logs, maintenance of the Native Seed Library, and assisting with community events and food delivery.
